Directions

From New York State Thruway (I-87)

Take Kingston Exit 19. Enter the traffic circle and take the second right onto I-587 and go about one mile. At the traffic light go through the intersection to Broadway. Follow Broadway through about 10 traffic lights. After Broadway bears sharply to the right turn left at the next traffic light staying on Broadway. Follow the signs to the Historic Rondout Waterfront. The festival is at the bottom of the hill along the waterfront between the Steelhouse Restaurant and the bridge over the Rondout.

From the Kingston-Rhinecliff Bridge

Cross the bridge and exit onto Route 32 (first exit after the bridge). Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Route 32 south. Follow the green Historic Rondout Waterfront signs. Turn left at the light onto Route 9W south. At the second light, turn right onto Garraghan Drive. Turn left at the traffic light onto Broadway. The festival is at the bottom of the hill along the waterfront between the Steelhouse Restaurant and the bridge over the Rondout.

From 9W and Points south of Kingston

Follow Route 9W north through Port Ewen. After crossing Rondout Creek, turn left at the first traffic light onto Garraghan Drive. Turn left at the traffic light onto Broadway. The festival is at the bottom of the hill along the waterfront between the Steelhouse Restaurant and the bridge over the Rondout.
